In phonics this week we would be focusing on the 'ck' sound. This is known as a diagraph (two letters that make one sound). We would teach children that 'ck' is found at the end of the word; we tend to find the rhyme "ck at the end needs a friend" helps the children remember! Some words that you may want to practise with are: sock, kick, pack, duck, rock, tick etc. Some activities that you may want to do include: listening for 'ck' at the end of words; reading CVC words with 'ck' at the end and building CVC words with flashcards.
