In phonics this week we would be focusing on the 'k' sound. We would be learning the letter name and the pure sound. We would be practising hearing initial sounds and orally blending CVC words (see last weeks newsletter for more info on this). Words that could be used to practise the 'k' sound are: kit, kite, kangaroo, kitten etc. If your child is reading/writing/building CVC words with flashcards then please use words that only use the sounds that we have learnt.
