Emily was busy working on her art projects. Here is her picture of ballerina, with a pink bracelet she made, and some portraits on which she used a pencil smudging technique.







He then painted lots of different bits of paper from the recycling then once they were dry he made a collage inspired by the artist Matisse.











#### Chloe's Blueberry Muffins

#### Ingredients


110g/4oz plain flour
110g/4oz butter
65g/2½oz caster sugar
2 free-range eggs
1½ tsp baking powder
125g/4½oz blueberries,
or equivalent in
frozen blueberries
pinch freshly
grated nutmeg
double cream, to serve

#### Method

Cream the butter and sugar together then slowly add the eggs, mix for three minutes. Add the flour, baking powder, nutmeg, stir to combine, then refrigerate for at least an hour, preferably overnight.


Place a spoonful of muffin mixture into each muffin case, filling each to just over half way. Stud each muffin with about eight blueberries.

Bake in an oven set at 200C/180C Fan/Gas 6 for 20 minutes, or until golden on top. Serve with cream.








