In phonics this week we would be focusing on the letter 'r'. We would be learning the letter name and the pure sound. We would continue to embed our ability to hear initial sounds by finding the objects that begin with the 'r' sound e.g. rug, rocket, rabbit, run, red etc. We would also continue to orally blend and segment CVC words containing 'r' and maybe even try reading and writing/building CVC words e.g. red, run, rip, rat, rock.
