Choo-Choo Words

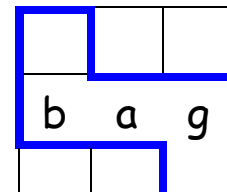
Write the entire list end-to-end as one long word (like a train). Use a different coloured crayon for each word.
