## Home Learning Challenges

In the Twinkl Originals book, 'We Are All Different', all of the children have different colours and types of hair. Look in the mirror. What colour is your hair? Is it long or short? Curly or straight?



Ask a grown-up to help you to make a healthy fruit salad using the characters' favourite fruits: strawberries, apples, bananas and grapes. Add your favourite fruit too.

Which pet is your favourite? Ask a grown-up to help you to find out and write a little bit about how to care for that pet.



The children in the book have lots of different types of families. Can you draw and label your family? You could bring in your picture to show to the class.



In the book, the children liked different colours. What is your favourite colour? Can you make a large rainbow on the floor outside, using different coloured paints or chalks? Try to count the number of colours. Use your fingers to help you.

Some of the children in the book could speak in different languages. Ask a member of your family to teach you to say 'hello' in a foreign language.
