



Enforced School Closure Home Learning Project Ideas Year 1

Find out about who lived and worked in a castle.	Find out about Medieval Banquets, then design your own feast to have in the Great Hall.
Design your own family shield.	Imagine you are at a joust, write a diary entry explaining what it was like.
Plant a seed, watch it grow and bring in back into school with you.	Practise phonics screening by visiting https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/phonics-screening-check-2019-materials (and other years are available just change the date in the search).
Find 20 things around your house that fit into a cereal box.	Identify 2D and 3D shapes around your house and make a tally chart of the shape that appears the most often.
Make a model out of old boxes/containers/items at home or playdough	How are castles defended? Can you make a trebuchet or battering ram or a siege tower?
Take a mirror. Have a look at yourself, study carefully your face and features and draw your own portrait.	Find out about a famous castle within the UK.
Learn a little rhyme and perform it for your family on a topic of your choice.	Keep a diary about the weather each day for a week, make an entry at breakfast time, lunchtime and tea time. What weather did you see most of? Choose one day and do your own weather forecast which could be shared with your family.
Go on Go Noodle (website) daily or set yourself another physical challenge e.g Mon – 10 star jumps, Tues - 15, Wed – 20 without giving up!	Read a story from The Bible and retell it in words and pictures.
