




**Enforced School Closure Home Learning Project Ideas Year 1**

**Reading and Comprehension**

Discuss what 'ravenous' means.

What words are rhyming in the story?

Tell someone what the story was about/ orally retell the story.

*\*Challenge\* - how many words has the author used to mean eating. For example, scoff and munch.*

**Writing**

Write a description of The Ravenous Beast using capital letters, full stops, conjunction 'and' and adjectives (small, fat, red, funny etc) and a description of another character/animal from the story.

Write and finish the following sentence: I am so hungry I could eat...

The big eared elephant comes down from the sky in a parachute! Find out about Leonardo da Vinci's designs and inventions for the parachute. Here are some useful links:


