



Enforced School Closure Home Learning Project Ideas Year 2

Think of a famous person who embodies one of our school values. Draw a picture of them and write why they embody that value E.g. Florence Nightingale she would represent kindness and perseverance.	Create a tally chart for the number and the colours of cars that pass your house within a 45 minute period.
Use Purple Mash to create a fact file about Captain Cook.	Investigate and find out what grows around your house, can you research and name the plants? Make a bar chart or a tally chart to show which is the most popular.
Create a piece of art work inspired by Andy Goldsworthy.	Bake some biscuits look carefully at the measurements on the recipe, can you re-write a recipe with half the amount or double the amount?
Collect leaves or flower specimens, dry or press them and then stick them into your book. Please label the specimens.	Use 2paint to design a picture of repeated patterns.
Whilst travelling in Tahiti, Darwin slept in a shelter made by the local people. He woke to the sound of heavy rain pouring on his banana leaf roof. In his journal, Darwin wrote about the people he had met and how they used the plants that grew around them in their everyday life. What do you use plants for?	
Write your own Easter poem.	What ten items would you take on a desert island? Draw them and explain why you would take them to aid your survival.
Write a poem and perform it for your family on a topic of your choice.	Make an Eco collage using household items e.g of an ocean creature.
Go on Go Noodle (website) daily or set yourself another physical challenge e.g Mon – 10 star jumps, Tues - 15, Wed – 20 without giving up!	Practise and put on a puppet show to tell a well-known traditional tale.
Make your own project about a famous person of your choice, they can be alive or from history. What can you find out about them?	Plan a dance to a song or music of your choice. Can it tell a story? Can it show your feelings?
