To all of our wonderful Year 4 Children,

We hope you and your families are all well and that you are looking after each other. The staff continue to think about you all everyday and are so very proud of the responsible and sensible young people that you are.

As you start to get ready for your new school, we wanted to give you the chance to ask questions that you really want to know answers to, and also to find out answers to questions that you may not have already thought of.

Therefore, we have been speaking a lot with your new schools and we have asked them if our St Nicholas Year 4 children could ask them some questions that they would really like answering. It needs to be a very important question and not something like 'What is there for lunch on a Tuesday?', although you might ask things like 'What sort of clubs are there at lunchtime?'.

If you would like to ask a question, here is what you need to do (with help from a grown-up):

- Go to the St Nicholas Year 4 Transition Page [here](#) and click on 'Ask a Question'. This will take you to a very grown-up form that you need to fill in.
- You will need to tell us your name, your new school and then you can ask one really important question. We ask that you choose **one** really important question only because we can find any that are similar really quickly, so we have some space for more questions.
- Then click 'Submit' - this will send it to Mr Gough, who will work with Mrs Deas to find questions that we think are so very important. We might not be able to answer them all (there are over 60 of you!), so please do not worry. If we think some questions are similar, we will put them together to create one question. Later

on, if you are still thinking about that question and it has been answered, please ask your grown-ups to email us and we will try and find out for you.

Some of you will be going to different schools so when and how we can get their questions to you might be a little bit different, but don't worry we will let you know when we have your answers ready!

Please send your questions in by 9am on Monday, 15th June 2020 so we can start to look through them.
